1) Income Tax Calculation:

Equal or less than RMB 4800	Tax-deductible
Greater than RMB 4800	Taxable income

2) Tax Rate Table:

Grade	Net chargeable income when exceeding RMB 4800	Tax rate (%)	Deduction for fast calculation
1	0-1500	3%	0
2	1500-4500	10%	105
3	4500-9000	20%	555
4	9000-35000	25%	1005

Example:

John earns RMB 9200 per month. Of this 9200, RMB 4800 is tax-deductible (see table 1). To find out how much tax he should pay, John makes the following calculation:

$$9200 - 4800 = 4400 \text{ (net taxable income)}$$

4400 falls under grade 2 tax rate (see table 2).

$$\begin{aligned} &4400 \times 10\% \\ &\quad - 105 \text{ (deduction for fast calculation)} \\ &= 335 \end{aligned}$$

John's income tax is RMB 335 per month.
